GENERAL EDUCATION (37 SEMESTER HRS / 12 COURSES)

Requirements include foundations of online learning, English, history, literature and humanities, science and mathematics, political science, and social sciences.

CORE COURSES (24 SEMESTER HRS / 8 COURSES)

Students must take 8 core courses:

- » History of U.S. Intelligence
- » Research Methods in Intelligence Studies
- » Introduction to Intelligence
- » Intelligence Collection
- » The U.S. Intelligence Community
- » Law and Ethics in Intelligence
- » Critical Analysis
- » Intelligence Analysis

MAJOR COURSES (24 SEMESTER HRS / 8 COURSES)

Students must take 8 major courses. Concentrations are offered in:

- » Criminal Intelligence
- » Intelligence Analysis
- » Intelligence Collection
- » Intelligence Operations
- » Terrorism Studies

A student enrolled in a concentration must take 4 major courses from his/her concentration area and 4 courses from the "General Program Course," not including those from the concentration.

Select major courses include:

- » Geographic Intelligence
- » International Criminal Organizations
- » Human Intelligence

ELECTIVES (33 SEMESTER HRS / 11 COURSES)

Students may choose from other courses not taken to meet required, core, or major requirements.

CAPSTONE COURSE (3 SEMESTER HOURS)

- » Senior Seminar in Intelligence Studies
